Summary:

When Skye, the most popular girl in the 8th grade, starts to receive threatening emails, text messages and voice-mails, she doesn't know what to do. Her best friend Melody asks the tech-savvy Adina for help. When Adina says yes, her friend Clara is confused. Skye is stuck up, and has never been nice to them in the past, so why is Adina helping her? After an adventure, the girls learn about more than just the bully's identity-- they learn about friendship and growing up in the digital age of technology.

7. Write an essay about how the age of technology affects society
8. Make a chart about the pros and cons of technology
9. Invite speakers to come and do an anti-bullying presentation at your school or for your class
10. Create your own anti-bullying presentation and present it to your class or school
